The location of the University is 27 Km from Lumbini, in Nepal and 135 Km of Sravasti, religious destination of buddhists. The nearest railway station is Siddharth Nagar and airport is 90 Kms i.e Mahayogi Gorakhnath airport, Gorakhpur.
